Footnotes

QUOIT QUICK broke a step slow but quickly reached contention four wide, stalked the pace under a rating hold, continued four wide into the lane, closed determinedly under pressure and wore down HEAVY ARTILLERY in the final forty yards. HEAVY ARTILLERY saved ground under rating, steadied nearing the far turn, angled out then advanced between rivals leaving the three furlong marker, moved to command in upper stretch, spurted clear in mid stretch then gave way grudgingly. VIA CON CLASE was outrun early, came five wide for the drive and rallied mildly. SAVE THE GREEN prompted pace three wide and continued willingly between rivals. BURREN shot through along the rail near the five furlong marker to take over, drew clear under some rating, was overtaken in upper stretch and tired in the final sixteenth of a mile. BETRAY saved ground under rating in the opening stages then made a mild late run between horses. FIRM HALO lost ground racing four to five wide. SPINNING MISS had a wide trip. NEEDADATE lacked speed and raced very wide in upper stretch. WEE BURN raced wide and between rivals into the lane but lacked a rally. KING BISHOPS RUBY went to an early lead two wide, stalked the pace once headed then faltered nearing the quarter pole. KYRENIA lost ground four to six wide and dropped back after a half mile.
