### Footnotes

CHECKS CASHED , in close quarters near the four and a half furlongs pole, raced three wide leaving the turn, took the lead in midstretch and held sway. WOHALI saved ground, bid for the lead in upper stretch and hung. TUXEDO PARK , very wide in the stretch, rallied. BRASILIER , checked in tight quarters leaving the backstretch, raced near the rail on the turn, angled out in midstretch and came up empty in the drive. ARGENT ET ROMEO lacked speed, raced very wide and passed tired rivals. BARTOK'S BANKER stalked the pace, swung wide entering the stretch and gave way. JAZZKING was not a factor. JAZZY LIL' STEVIE was no factor. INNER PASSION , extremely wide turning for home, was outrun. KNUT dropped back. CIGAR BAR came in to avoid a horse soon after the break, set the pace in the two path, drifted in near the three sixteenths pole and stopped.
