LION DRAWING was carried out some early, lost ground four to six wide and lacked a late response. CROW BAR came in at the break and failed to menace. HOBE SOUND moved up along the rail into the turn, chased the winner into the stretch and weakened. AARON'S LEGEND broke slowly, was hustled up soon after, chased briefly and dropped back. AEGEUS was outrun while off the rail. MONEY'S VENTURE was steadied at the break.
