WOODEN STONE set a rated pace inside, took pressure leaving the far turn, opened up when roused in upper stretch then held sway under steady handling. INDEPENDENT GEORGE settled off the rail, circled four to five wide into the lane and closed willingly. HERE COMES ART , well placed early off the rail, came three wide for the drive, drifted in late and lacked a solid finish. HE DEVIL saved ground, rallied mildly along the rail and steadied at the wire. LOGARITIMO (ARG) was steadied leaving the three quarter pole, saved ground into the far turn, angled out and lacked the needed response. IRISH OSPREY , unhurried early, raced towards the inside into the lane, steadied briefly leaving the eighth pole and was under a hand ride late. TITLED broke slowly, was hustled up to contention from the outside, pressed the pace outside the winner, faltered in upper stretch. An objection by the rider of HE DEVIL against HERE COMES ART for alleged interference near the wire was not allowed.
