RANDOM STAR went quickly clear,dictated the pace off the rail and edged away under a drive. HOWABOUTTHISWON stalked the pace 3-wide, advanced in upper stretch and drifted in. BRUSHED ON settled towards the inside, eased out for the drive and closed. SHOCK VALUE lost ground 4-wide and failed to respond. ALL INITIALS chased the pace between horses and weakened. VERIMAR EXPRESS rushed to contention inside, chased the pace and tired.
