BRONZE ABE quickly went clear, set a fast pace under rating, was set down in upper stretch and held clear under a drive. SPELLING raced in closest pursuit two wide and finished gamely to be much the best of the rest. ASKARA , bumped at the break, raced well back early, came very wide for the drive and rallied mildly. WHO'S YA MAMA saved ground into the lane and failed to respond. CARNIE'S DANCER chased the pace, came four wide for the drive but failed to threaten. NO HALOS HERE moved up three wide into the turn, chased the pace and faded. THE FIFTH ELEMENT lost ground four wide and never menaced.
