PERFECT BLUE , unhurried early, swung four wide leaving the far turn, opened a clear advantage in midstretch and prevailed under urging. A QUEEN'S SMILE saved ground around the far turn, chased the pace and finished willingly. ARAB MISS saved ground to the far turn, swung three wide approaching the stretch and lacked the needed rally. IMPOLITE set the pace off the rail and gave way. WORLDLY PLEASURE , outrun, was eased. CHRUSCIKI , outrun, was eased. NICLIE chased the pace three wide, stopped and was eased.
