MAJESTIC SLEWVILLE , sent to the front, set the pace near the rail and drew away under brisk urging. TRAE'S LADY , two wide, chased the winner in a game effort. CALDERA PEAK lacked speed, raced along the rail on the turn, eased out to the two path in upper stretch and rallied between horses. MISS CHESTERVALLEY lacked speed, raced between horses through the stretch and passed tired ones. ROYAL SWEETHEART raced forwardly along the rail and weakened. NATTIE NU was no factor. TUFF PARTNERS , wide, was no factor. PARTNERS LUCK raced in the three path entering the turn, drifted wide entering the stretch and gave way. TO THE CROWD , very wide entering the stretch, gave way.
