Footnotes

HIGH HILL, outrun early while saving ground, angled out three to four wide for the drive, closed sharply under left handed pressure and drew clear late. SUZZONA rated close up, inherited the lead along the rail mid turn, opened up a lengthy lead in upper stretch, had her misjudge the wire with about seventy yards to go and was run down. CATCHING chased the pace, made a two wide run entering the stretch then flattened out. TEJANO SEA had some belated action but failed to menace. SWALLOW FALLS, between rivals early, came four wide for the drive and failed to respond. SALTWATER TAFFY, forwardly placed early, saved ground and faded. JULIA rushed wide to contention, was carried out five wide mid turn and faded. BINDLOE broke a step slow, lost ground four to five wide and failed to menace. IMPOSSIBLE TUNE sprinted to the early lead, bore out mid turn and was pulled up.
