BEARZAVA , eased out three wide near the five sixteenths pole, brushed with SHAMELESS RISK near the eighth pole then drew clear. C FOUR , angled to the rail near the half mile pole, saved ground around the turn, swung outside in upper stretch and rallied. SHAMELESS RISK showed speed in the two path, drifted out and brushed with the winner in midstretch and weakened in the drive. LORD WILLING dropped back a bit on the turn, was in the two path in midstretch, angled to the rail near the sixteenth pole and rallied. TRIXTER showed speed along the rail and weakened. DANCIN BUDDHA lacked speed and passed tired rivals. BIG JIM M. , wide, was not a factor. MILITARY COURAGE stumbled leaving the starting gate, raced wide around the turn and gave way. BRUSHED LUSTRE , three wide on the turn, faltered
