### Footnotes

SUPPOSEDLY stalked the pace near the rail, eased out three wide entering the stretch, bid for command approaching the eighth pole then drew out under steady handling. QUIT QUICK stalked the pace two wide, bid for the lead midway on the far turn, dueled to midstretch and weakened. NO HALOS HERE took the lead at once, set the pace along the rail and gave way the final furlong. WASIOTO raced off the rail in an even effort. ACE UP HER SLEEVE chased the pace three wide and stopped.
