Footnotes

ART FAN prompted the pace two wide, moved clear into the lane, widened in mid stretch, drifted a bit then was fully extended to prevail. SLOW AND STEADY , two wide down the backstretch, was put to strong urging leaving the three furlong marker, angled out three wide for the drive, closed steadily and simply ran out of ground. HELLO GITANA , unhurried early, raced four wide around the far turn and rallied mildly. RUNNIN UTE cleared early, set the a slow pace towards the inside, took pressure around the far turn, remained serious contender to the head of the lane then surrendered. SIMPLE AFFAIR , bumped at the break, raced four wide around the first turn, continued off the rail stalking the pace, was put to urging around the final turn and weakened. IRREPRESSIBLESPEED angled in early, moved up off the rail near the half mile marker, steadied when in tight three furlongs out and failed to recover. SWEET SARAH stalked the pace three wide to the far turn and faltered. FREEDOM PEAKS , fractious in the gate, saved ground and faltered.
