NAIVE MELODY raced near the rail on the turn and rallied between rivals. IN TOO DEEP saved ground and weakened. SINGAPORE CHARLEY raced very wide entering the stretch and weakened. DIABLO'S COUNTESS chased the pace three wide and gave way. INCASED IN GOLD , pinched back leaving the starting gate, raced wide into the lane. CINDY LOU SLEW set the pace in the two path and stopped.
