HE DEVIL saved ground, eased outside when commencing his rally in upper stretch, swept to command in midstretch then prevailed under brisk urging. SEIZE , steadied in close quarters entering the first turn, raced wide on the far turn and rallied. PRIVATE SCANDAL , unhurried early, saved ground and rallied. MR NOTEBOOK , wide the first turn, raced very wide on the far turn and rallied. BURNING RAMBO raced in the three path and gave way. MAGICAL

GEM raced along the rail and was no factor. ABBE'S CHESTNUT raced between horses and failed to rally. PALISTAR passed tired rivals. PLEASE SMILE , no factor, raced wide turning for home. RUBI ECHO was outrun. JACOB'S ARCH , in traffic in midstretch, gave way. WALDEN POND set the pace and faltered in midstretch. NONNO LUIGI (BRZ) , two wide, faltered. TUFF LOVER , wide the far turn, was outrun.
