### Footnotes

RUSH W , taken to rate four wide early off of a contested pace, moved closer off the rail nearing the lane, angled out and rallied five wide under pressure to poke a head in mid stretch, dueled then edged clear late under a solid drive. BAILOUT PLAN moved up between rivals nearing the half mile marker to gain a stalking position, rated towards the inside around the turn, angled out three wide into the lane, lodged a bid between rivals in upper stretch, dueled past the furlong marker, drifted in late and stayed on well. CRAFTY SON , away alertly, set a pressured pace into the turn, dueled along the rail from the quarter pole to the eighth pole then gave way grudgingly in the final seventy yards. MO'S BRO , three wide early, dueled two wide around the turn, battled between rivals in mid stretch and weakened late. LEGAL PAD , bumped at the break, raced four wide early chasing the pace, continued off the rail around the turn and failed to respond. J TRAIN , inside early, angled out near the three eighths pole, came five to six wide for the drive but lacked a solid finish. ZIP ALONG saved ground without a rally. MC TAGGART broke slowly and was outrun. NAUGHTY SARAVA was bumped and in tight at the break. SGT. BART , wide, failed to keep pace.
