Footnotes

RED MALONE stalked the pace three to four wide, closed determinedly under pressure and got up in the final yards. HE GOT THE NUMBER set a pressured pace towards the inside, shook clear in the drive but just could not withstand the winner. DOUBLE TOLLGATE chased the pace while saving ground and finished willingly. KELP broke a step slow then was bumped soon after, worked his way between rivals then was outfinished in the final furlong. JOEL'S TOUCH , bumped and in tight soon after the start, advanced along the inside in upper stretch, eased out late and finished with interest. PANUCO had a four to five wide trip, chased the pace and lacked a solid response. LORD SMELLINGTON vied two to three wide and weakened in the final sixteenth. UP HILL SURVIVOR chased early, was shuffled back entering the turn and failed to recover. ZURVAN , well wide throughout, failed to menace. CHAPLAIN CHARLIE , bumped soon after the start, was taken up entering the turn and failed to recover.
