Footnotes

STAR TRACE prompted the pace two wide while in hand, put a head in front in mid stretch, edged clear and won under a mild drive. TYASKIN steadied soon after the start, advanced between rivals on the turn, came three wide for the drive and finished gamely. SPEED FREAK went clear early, set a quick pace along the inside and weakened late. ROSSO TOSCANO, outrun early, made a mild run between horses mid way on the turn then flattened out. ONE MORE POWER, five wide into the stretch, failed to menace. EXPECTED TAKEOVER saved ground and lacked a response. BASIC TRAINEE was outrun. SILVER'S PROSPECT chased the pace three wide, faltered and was not abused late. PROMPT PAYMENT was pulled up sore and vanned off.
