Footnotes

COLONEL BILL stalked the pace between horses, gained the lead inside rivals near the sixteenth pole and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. CHANGE OF COMMAND worked between horses on the far turn, left the bend in the four path and rallied outside the winner. AVERIL'S RING, forwardly placed between horses, had aim on the lead in midstretch then flattened out. FLY'N BAYOU, four wide the first turn, gained the lead outside rivals on the far turn and faded in the drive. PUNTA SAL lacked speed, saved ground and rallied. SHARP NUMBERS rushed up very wide leaving the far turn, reached the lead in upper stretch and tired in the drive. SAINTLY LOVE lacked speed, had some run in the stretch and was steadied, lacking room near the sixteenth pole. POLLARDS IMAGE, steadied in tight quarters entering the first turn, lost ground both turns and weakened in the drive. URBAN JUNGLE, very wide both turns, was not a factor. FAST TEMPO saved ground, chased the pace and gave way. SENOR QUICKIE was outrun. IRUNALATTE, outrun, was steadied in close quarters leaving the backstretch. AWESOME BLITZ dropped back. TRUE CHANGE set the pace, stopped and returned bleeding.
