JAZZY IDEA , patiently handled early, angled out entering the turn, circled five wide advancing into the stretch, responded when straightened away in upper stretch, forged to command leaving the eighth pole and eagerly widened under a mild drive. COLONY CLUB rated forwardly while towards the inside, angled four wide for the drive, closed willingly and outfinished QUEEN CHATANIKA for the place. QUEEN CHATANIKA broke slowly, was hustled soon after and moved up five wide nearing the turn, gained quickly mid turn, challenged for command into the stretch and stayed on well. CAROLE'S LOVE set the pace inside, took pressure into the lane, remained in front just past the furlong marker then gave way grudgingly. THISDANSEISTAKEN saved ground in range, steadied when in close entering the turn, altered out in the drive and finished with good energy. BOLD AFFAIR , a bit sluggish from the gate, was caught four wide between rivals into the turn, chased and lacked a bid. CALLIOPE failed to menace. PURELY LOVE stalked the pace, lodged a bid early turn, vied between into the lane then gave way. GIN SWEEP lacked speed, swung widest and failed to menace.
