Footnotes

DOOTS , well placed stalking the pace along the rail, eased out leaving the eighth pole, forged to command forty yards out and proved best under a drive. GATOR'S TRACKS gained command between rivals soon after the break, set the pace on a clear lead, was collared near the sixteenth marker and battled gamely to the wire. HONEY'S SKY stalked the pace two to three wide, was urged along nearing the lane and held well. ICY LADY , unhurried early while saving ground, swung wide entering the lane and finished with good energy. MARIAH'S MOON lost ground three to four wide and came up empty. GREAT BRIDGE , between rivals nearing the half mile marker, raced four wide in upper stretch and lacked a closing kick. RIVER KWAI , well placed, gave way. ACADEMIC QUEEN lost ground chasing the early pace and gave way leaving the far turn. FLOWER FLAG , three wide early, gave way.
