Footnotes

SOUTHERN REGION saved ground setting the pace, opened up in midstretch and was kept to his business in the drive. A P ELVIS broke alertly to have speed along the rail, dropped back when he buck jumped early, swung very wide in the stretch and rallied gamely. SINGLE MALT MAC saved ground in a game effort. JAKE RATTLE N ROLL , blocked behind horses in upper stretch, angled out near the eighth pole then impeded two rivals when lugging in near the sixteenth pole. LOVE THOSE BOOTS , six wide entering the stretch, passed tired foes. CLASS RULES prompted the pace outside the winner and weakened in the drive. FLEETER , between horses in the stretch, was steadied in tight quarters near the sixteenth pole. COP A TUDE was not a factor. STEADY WARRIOR stalked the pace, was in the four path in upper stretch, failed to rally and was steadied in tight quarters inside JAKE RATTLE N ROLL near the sixteenth pole. QUITE A DUDE , wide on the turn, gave way. Following objections by the riders of FLEETER and STEADY WARRIOR, JAKE RATTLE N ROLL was disqualified and placed ninth for impeding those two in the stretch drive.
