**Footnotes**

JEWEL OF A CAT , rushed up wide entering the turn, sprinted clear entering the stretch and lasted under pressure. BACKYARD BOOGIE , off the rail, chased the winner and closed the gap late in a sharp effort. TOURING HONG KONG lacked speed, moved up between horses in upper stretch and rallied outside. SNOW PRINCESS , reluctant to load into the starting gate, steadied soon after the break, was well back entering the stretch and rallied. SING THE BLUES , very wide turning for home, failed to sustain her bid. CLAPIFYOUBELIEVE chased the pace and weakened. MY CRAZY LIVI prompted the pace well off the rail and gave way in upper stretch. STORMY ADVENTURE weakened. WISESTAR showed speed inside horses and faltered. TAKE THE TRAIN dropped back and was distanced.
