REGAL SOLO broke slowly, saved ground under patient handling on the turn, eased out in upper stretch, was alertly angled back to the inner rail in midstretch, was bumped by TOMORROW'S TALE inside the sixteenth pole, closed and drove clear. TOMORROW'S TALE chased the pace while saving ground, drifted off the rail in upper stretch, was bumped by TRAPEZIUM STAR and forced into REGAL SOLO inside the sixteenth pole and weakened. TRAPEZIUM STAR, quickly clear, controlled the pace around the turn, drifted wide in upper stretch, bumped TOMORROW'S TALE when drifting in near the sixteenth pole and weakened. ADIRONDACK KING, wide, dropped back on the turn then offered a belated rally outside horses. MASS DESTRUCTION chased the pace, drifted wide in upper stretch and gave way. WILDCAT BRIEF broke slowly and trailed.
