STAR MONEY , angled to the two path near the five eighths pole, gained the lead outside KINDA KATTY in upper stretch, opened a clear lead, ran on her left lead and lasted under brisk urging. QUEENAMEINA , steadied leaving the starting gate, circled the turn four wide, floated to the five path near the quarter pole and rallied late. IDLE HOUR bumped with ANN MILLER near the seven eighths pole, angled to the inner rail leaving the turn and rallied inside horses. BEE TOUCHED , along the rail down the backstretch, eased out on the turn, angled to the four path entering the stretch then gave way. ANN MILLER bumped with IDLE HOUR near the seven eighths pole, was well off the rail and dropped back. KINDA KATTY opened a clear, early lead, set the pace along the rail and faltered in upper stretch. CHLOE CAROL trailed.
