HONORABLE MAN , unhurried, swung five wide entering the stretch, closed eagerly, was under brisk urging in the drive and drew off. SAAY MI NAME set the pace near the rail and gave way grudgingly. CHEROKEE'S BOY stalked the pace, raced in the three path entering the stretch and gave way. UNFORGETTABLE MAX bore in leaving the starting gate, raced in the four path in the stretch and failed to rally. POLISH PRIDE , forced back leaving the starting gate, was lightly steadied on the heels of a rival in upper stretch, raced very wide in the drive and failed to menace. YOUR BLUFFING raced inside horses and came up empty. PEEPING TOM , wide, stopped. IMPLICIT prompted the pace racing along the rail and stopped.
