WILDCAT BRIEF , outrun early, came under a ride leaving the far turn, angled out five wide advancing into the stretch, closed under stout left handed pressure, drifted in a bit while on his left lead leaving the sixteenth marker and forged ahead in the final jumps. SLOANE RANGER broke outward, advanced three to four wide in upper stretch, closed between rivals, briefly took a slim advantage in deep stretch then just missed in a sharp effort. COMEDERO cleared early, set a quick pace under a light hold, was asked for his best leaving the three sixteenths marker, remained clear inside the eighth pole, drifted out once collared and gave way grudgingly. SUPER ROBUSTO lacked speed while saving ground, worked his way out to about the six past inside the furlong marker and found his best too late. DEPUTY DANAY , four wide early, tracked COMEDERO two wide mid turn, held well to mid stretch then gave way. SANDBAGIN' LOVER was angled to the rail leaving the half mile marker, chased a quick pace and gave way through the drive.
