By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination. \$250 to pass the entry box, \$250 additional to start, with \$50,000 Guaranteed, (plus \$25,000 for Registered Maryland Breds) of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Unearned guaranteed purse money is split between the horses that start and finish the race. Supplemental nominations of \$500 each will be accepted by the usual time of entry with all other fees due as noted. Weights Three-Year-Olds 122 lbs. Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$40,000 at one mile or over in 2011, allowed 2 lbs.; \$30,000 twice at one mile or over in 2011, 4 lbs.; \$30,000 once at one mile or over in 2011, 6 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Preference to starters with highest career earnings in 2010-2011 on the turf. Horses may be placed on the also eligible list. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Trophy to the owner of the winner. Nominations closed Thursday September 1, 2011 with 30 nominations.

Footnotes

EIGHTTOFASTTOCATCH stalked the pace slightly off the rail, awaited room near the five sixteenths pole, swung to the four path near the quarter pole, took command in upper stretch, was under brisk urging and drew out. NACHO FRIEND prompted the pace outside ACTION ANDY, drifted out a bit when gaining a brief lead entering the stretch, weakened in the drive and held the place. INDIAN DANCE lacked speed, raced wide on the turn, was floated to the six path near the quarter pole when reaching a striking position then weakened. CHEROKEE ARTIST, unhurried early, was floated to the five path near the quarter pole and weakened through the lane. POCKET PATCH stalked the pace well off the rail, was steadied in tight quarters entering the stretch then gave way. ACTION ANDY set a pressured pace along the rail and gave way in upper stretch. SUMACHA'HOT, in close quarters leaving the starting gate, trailed.
