Footnotes

FLY THE ATLANTIC set the pace in the two path, opened up on the backstretch, remained two wide and prevailed under pressure. SNOBBY SCAMP , unhurried early, raced three wide on the turns, angled to the rail in upper stretch, had aim on the lead in midstretch then flattened out. SWEET TIM , two wide the far turn, had a slight rally. ART OF ATTACK , inside horses on the far turn, chased the pace and gave way in upper stretch. STOCKTON BAD BEN , very wide leaving the far turn, passed tired horses. RANGER CRIS , three wide the first turn, faltered. ADAM'S TURN hugged the rail and stopped. SNAKE EATER , outrun, stopped in upper stretch and was eased late.
