**Footnotes**

DE CHERA saved ground disputing the pace, opened a clear lead in midstretch, drifted out late and lasted. MONEY FOR LOVE lacked speed, raced wide around the far turn, reached a striking position near the sixteenth pole, was floated out late and hung. DIP MY BEAK , three wide entering the stretch, angled out in midstretch and had a mild rally. PEACE FIRE lacked speed, raced off the rail, swung to the four path leaving the far turn and passed tired rivals. INTO THE WIND , wide the first turn, was used passing horses down the backstretch, circled the far turn and tired the final furlong. MEDIA SPEED disputed the pace outside the winner and weakened the final eighth of a mile. POLLARDS IMAGE , wide the first turn, remained well off the rail, stalked the pace and gave way leaving the far turn. NOT FOR PRIDE bore out leaving the starting gate, was rated back early, swung wide in midstretch and failed to be a factor. RUN TO THE SUN , in tight quarters leaving the starting gate, saved ground on the far turn and was not a factor. DETROIT IRON was outrun. ITINERIS , in tight quarters leaving the starting gate, raced wide around the first turn and faltered.
