PUT HER BACK ZACH , forward between rivals early, eased back off the pace into the turn, came under pressure past the three eighths pole, swung out five wide for the drive, closed determinedly under strong handling and forged ahead in the final strides. SURRENDERTHEMONEY moved up inside rivals to take command with five furlongs remaining, set a pressured pace towards the rail, came under a ride entering the lane, briefly edged clear a sixteenth out, continued gamely but just could not withstand the winner's charge. HEY SOUL SISTER rated early off the rail, quickly moved four wide to entertain the pace, pressed three wide into the lane and stayed on willingly. TRIPLE PICK tracked the pace three wide, moved three wide between foes early turn, pressed between rivals into the lane and gave way grudgingly. SWEET VALOR advanced under a light hold along the rail to be close up into the turn, dropped back a bit mid turn, was asked for her best in upper stretch but came up empty. WENDYBIRD , sluggish from the gate, raced well back into the turn, saved ground into the stretch and lacked a rally. YENTE gained a slim early advantage between rivals, continued to dispute the pace leaving the three and a half furlong marker, faltered and was eased.
