RECKLESS RUNNER broke slowly, recovered and advanced inside rivals to take command near the three quarter pole, edged clear approaching the turn and was nicely rated, responded when set down in upper stretch and held firm. ZARROC prompted the winner two wide, came under pressure mid turn and stayed on well to be clear of the rest. ROYAL STRAIGHT stalked the pace three wide and went evenly through the drive. SLICK VIC dropped back to last after an alert start, remained four to five wide, commenced a run mid turn and finished up willingly. I KNOW WHY, well placed in about the two path, lacked a bid. KEY TO A CURE, between rivals mid turn, failed to rally. SUN DANCE MOON stumbled at the break, was angled in early, was hard ridden along the rail mid turn and gave way. LACROSSE MOON hopped at the break then was outrun.
