Footnotes

BIG DUTCH chased the pace outside STORMY HORIZON, closed determinedly the final furlong and drove clear. WHATA SOANDSO, between horses the far turn, angled out in midstretch and rallied. STORMY HORIZON, two wide the first turn, sprinted clear entering the backstretch, angled to the rail, set the pace to midstretch then gave way late. FOREIGN REVIEW, swung outside entering the backstretch, lost ground four wide on the far turn and failed to rally. PRIVACY INVASION, rated back early, saved ground on the far turn, swung wide in upper stretch and offered a mild, late rally. SPINNAKER BAY saved ground the first turn, was off the rail on the far turn and failed to rally. SEE WHAT IT IS, along the rail through the stretch, was not a factor. SABA ROCK saved ground and gave way in the stretch. BETH'S MOONSAIL was outrun. STOCKTON BAD BEN was outrun.
