SEEYOUINTHECITY , lightly steadied in traffic near the half mile pole, was patiently handled around the turn, swung to the five path in upper stretch, swept to command in midstretch and was ridden out. MCNAMARA , in the three path on the turn, chased the pace in a game effort. MONTEAGLE , three wide on the turn, angled outside near the sixteenth pole and closed the gap nicely. DEVEREUX saved ground, had room along the rail through the stretch but lacked the needed rally. SEATTLE PROSPECT , swung wide in upper stretch, passed tired rivals. QUITE A DUDE , wide around the turn, chased the pace to midstretch then gave way. HESA BIG STAR , lightly steadied in close quarters near the half mile pole, raced wide entering the stretch and turned in an even effort. PORONUI sped to the front, set the pace in the two path and gave way in midstretch. WOHALI saved ground to no avail. GIANT PATRIOT was not a factor. HAMMERING BUCKEYE , shuffled back soon after the break, saved ground and was no factor. FEDERAL HILL , very wide turning for home, was not a factor. GUNNER LOUIE , very wide leaving the turn, was outrun. ONE SUNDAY was outrun.
