ROCKY GAP settled early off the rail and off of a three pronged battle up front, commenced a run when roused three furlongs out, circled five wide into the stretch, closed strongly under left handed pressure, rolled by the dueling leaders with about seventy yards remaining and eagerly pulled away under mild encouragement. JUST SAYIN tracked the pacesetters under rating, angled four wide leaving the five sixteenths marker, bid to near even terms entering the lane, dueled to the sixteenth pole, stayed on well and held the place. BEER IS GOOD dueled between rivals, held a short lead into the lane, battled inside JUST SAYIN to the sixteenth marker and gave way grudgingly. ST. JOHNSWOOD broke outward and was sluggish early while well off the inside, drifted out seven wide in upper stretch, got in when a bit green progressing leaving mid stretch, was straightened away and finished well. AIRSTREAM DRIVER, off slowly, lagged back around the turn, came seven wide for the drive and finished with interest. IRISH HUMOR broke a step slow, was outrun early, angled five wide in upper stretch and finished willingly between foes. SUN SONG, two wide leaving the three eighths pole, angled out some in the drive but lacked a solid finish. YUKON SPECIAL lodged an early three wide bid, dueled around the turn and gave way in upper stretch. SALT AND LIGHT flashed speed just behind the leaders, dropped back along the rail near the three eighths pole, shifted out in upper stretch and came back some between rivals. CHAMP'S METAL dueled inside rivals to the head of the lane and weakened. PEPPERMINT PRINCE chased the leaders four to five wide and tired in upper stretch. TIZREAL was outrun.
