Footnotes

CHICKAMAUGA stalked the pace, closed determinedly in close quarters between horses the final furlong and prevailed under strong handling. BREAK THE RECORD stalked the pace two wide on the turn, bid for the lead in midstretch, drifted out on the winner near the sixteenth pole and finished gamely to just

miss. FLIP THE SWITCH bore out leaving the starting gate, circled the turn, entered the track in the four path, had aim on the lead in midstretch, raced on her left lead and flattened out. TERLINGUA'S CAUSE along the rail in upper stretch, angled to the six path near the eighth pole and closed late. ZISTER sped to the front, set the pace near the rail and surrendered the final furlong. GOOD LOOKING GIRL , along the rail in the stretch, failed to rally. SIMPLE EXCHANGE , bumped and forced out by FLIP THE SWITCH leaving the starting gate, raced along the rail in the stretch and passed tired rivals. CALLIOPE was not a factor. JUNGLE JUICE , bumped leaving the starting gate, was outrun and passed some tired foes. LUCKY HOLLY was outrun. CHARLI SUNSHINE , wide on the turn, gave way. CHERRY WILDCAT gave way. DOLL DREAMS , no factor, drifted to the eight path entering the turn. REINE DE BONBON , very wide turning for home, was outrun.
