KATIE'S LOVE saved ground, eased out for the drive, gained the lead inside the sixteenth pole then weakened. PARISIANA stalked the pace, gained a clear lead turning for home and weakened late. NATTIE NU set the pace near the rail and weakened. PIANO BAR raced along the rail, swung wide entering the stretch and gave way. FOR THE TASTE raced well off the rail and gave way. KIP SMILE was outrun. MS. RISKAY stopped and was eased. GOLDEN AURA unseated her rider soon after the break.
