**Footnotes**

NOMANHAN , bumped at the break, quickly recovered and stalked the pace while saving ground, angled out mid turn, circled four wide into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging to take command leaving the eighth pole, kicked away and drifted in late. KNUT was hustled along early, moved to challenge three wide early turn, gained a short lead in upper stretch, was collared by the winner a furlong out, altered out late and just lasted for the place. FOXS UPTOWN BOY , outrun early, came four wide for the drive and rallied between rivals. PROBATE saved ground and continued on willingly. MO'S BRO lost ground four to five, advanced past the furlong marker, drifted in late and steadied off the heels of KNUT. KING'S RANSOM was shuffled back at the break, raced well back around the turn then closed willingly through the final furlong. BIG BOPER chased the pace while off the rail and faded. LEGAL PAD sprinted clear early, set the pace two wide, took pressure around the turn, was overtaken in upper stretch, tired leaving the eighth pole and steadied when in close inside the sixteenth marker. PAUL'S FINAL ONE , three wide chasing the early pace, raced six wide in the drive and weakened. CORRALITO'S WAY was outrun. JUNGLELAND was finished early. An objection by the rider of MO'S BRO against KNUT for alleged interference in the stretch was not allowed
