Footnotes

BUREAUCAT lacked speed, raced in the five path entering the stretch, closed and drew clear under pressure. FOUFA'S GEM saved ground stalking the pace, eased out three wide at the head of the stretch, had aim on the lead in upper stretch and flattened out. ABOUNDING HOPE, wide the far turn, was in the six path entering the stretch and rallied mildly. CALOCAGATHIA, unhurried early, raced wide entering the stretch and was lightly steadied when drifting in on the heels of a rival approaching the sixteenth pole. THIRTEENTH STORM stalked the pace, advanced two wide on the far turn, gained the lead in midstretch and tired. SURFING IN MALIBU prompted the pace and weakened in the stretch. SKIPPYS GATOR lacked speed and failed to rally. RED DIRT GIRL lacked speed and passed tired rivals. THEPRINCESS sped to the front, set the pace along the rail and gave way. QUEY TWO was outrun. TENACIOUS TRACI, three wide the first turn, faltered. ROYAL RUFFIE, no factor, gave way.
