Footnotes

ANIME saved ground under patient handling, lacked room behind three rivals in upper stretch, swung to the four path in midstretch, closed and narrowly prevailed. SOUP D'COUPE, four wide the first turn, was floated five wide entering the stretch and rallied late. BROADSIDE stalked the pace, circled the far turn, had aim on the lead in midstretch then flattened out. ARISE SIR KNIGHT stalked the pace, gained a short, two wide lead between horses in midstretch then weakened. SCHOOLHOUSE WOODS, swung to the four path entering the stretch, raced evenly. WILLIAM'S PRAYER had speed along the rail and gave way the final furlong. TOMCAT TIGER, three wide entering the stretch, drifted in near the three sixteenths pole then failed to rally. TEN MISSIONS prompted the pace two wide and gave way in upper stretch. TRUE CHANGE, shuffled back leaving the starting gate, drifted wide entering the first turn, angled to the rail on the backstretch and was outrun. TOUCH THE LIGHT was outrun. GREAT BRITAIN, outside horses, was put to urging near the half mile pole and fell back.
