TRUE BREEZE stalked the pace three wide under some rating, edged closer under urging past the five sixteenths marker, closed determinedly under pressure to collar CENIZO in mid stretch then forged clear while kept to solid encouragement. WHATABOOTIE , taken to rate early, moved up between rivals nearing the turn, came under a ride leaving the five sixteenths marker, angled five wide for the drive and closed willingly to just get the place. CENIZO sprinted clear, set the pace towards the inside, was collared nearing mid stretch, held well to the sixteenth marker then faded. TEA PARTY GAL stalked the pace, was ridden along mid turn and gave way in the final furlong. TERRA ROLLA stumbled along for several strides leaving the gate, recovered and angled to the rail soon after, was outrun to mid turn, swung out four wide entering the stretch and finished with interest. JULENE lacked speed, was floated out five wide entering the lane and failed to threaten. SINGITA CAT , ridden along chasing the pace inside, gave way in upper stretch. BETTERBEMBONTBROOK , forward early while saving ground, was shuffled back some nearing the turn, angled out mid turn and failed to recover.
