Footnotes

JOEL'S TOUCH set the pace along the rail and opened up under brisk urging in midstretch. NOMORESURPRISES lacked speed, raced along the rail on the turn, swung to the three path in upper stretch and gained the place. INISH SHANK raced in the two path between horses on the backstretch, angled to the rail leaving the turn and came up empty in the drive. SAMURAI PRINCE raced along the rail, eased out two wide entering the stretch and weakened. UNCLE HOWARD , a forward factor three wide, gave way. DUDE AGAIN trailed.
