**Footnotes**

GREAT HARBOUR stalked the pace, advanced three wide entering the stretch, swept to command in upper stretch and drew out while kept to his business. LET'S DO IT lacked speed, was wide entering the stretch, drifted in a bit near the three sixteenths pole and rallied. STEADY EDDIE lacked speed, raced wide turning for home, chased the winner and weakened late. GUSTAUFG saved ground stalking the pace, was lightly steadied on the heels of RASCALLION approaching the stretch, eased out at the head of the lane and lacked the needed rally. NAVY BRASS stalked the pace two wide and gave way. NOVEL NOTION lacked speed, was very wide entering the stretch and failed to be a factor. RASCALLION set the pace along the rail and gave way. SEASONALITY was outrun. PARADISE PRINCE raced along the rail entering the stretch and was outrun. KICKIN' CAT was outrun. DISPATCH dropped back and was eased late.
