PRIME MISTRESS disputed the pace two wide throughout the race and determinedly proved best. MIDSUMMER'S EVE stalked the pace, moved out four wide on the turn, dueled through the stretch while on her left lead and hung. SECRET LIFE OF BEA saved ground, eased out leaving the turn, was fanned to the five path entering the stretch then rallied. JOY TRAIN , three wide on the turn, chased the pace, bid for the lead turning for home and weakened the final furlong. OVER MARKETED , in the two path on the turn, swung to the four path entering the stretch and lacked the necessary rally. CENTRIPETAL MOTION saved ground and weakened. DANCE WITH JAMES saved ground while outrun. GIGI'S MANDATE dueled along the rail and gave way. SUGAH SWEET was outrun.
