Footnotes

WHATDOYOUSEE , taken to rate early, advanced two wide into the far turn, took aim off of a three pronged battle past the three eighths pole, angled four wide soon after, rallied to command past the three sixteenths pole and steadily edged away under a drive. VERSAILLES FOX settled inside, angled out gathering momentum mid way on the final turn, worked between horses in upper stretch and continued on willingly to gain the place. LE TROUBADOUR prompted the pace three wide, move to engage after a half mile, dueled from the far turn, popped a head in front after six furlongs, edged clear momentarily near the quarter pole, was confronted by the winner in upper stretch and gave way grudgingly. FINANCIER , unhurried early, lost ground most of the way, made a mild five wide in upper stretch then flattened out. PREMIUM JUSTICE stalked the pace off the rail, lodged a bid between foes after a half mile, dueled to the five sixteenths marker then faded in the drive. DILLONBEGON moved clear around the first turn, set the pace along the rail, was joined after four furlongs, dueled inside runners to the five sixteenths pole then tired. PERFECT LOCH , well placed three wide, was put to a ride nearing the far turn, failed to respond and faltered.
