Footnotes

DENVER DUEL lacked room inside horses near the three eighths pole, eased out four wide leaving the turn, closed outside foes and was along in time. SAFE NET moved up in the two path on the turn, gained the lead inside horses in upper stretch and gave way grudgingly. TOUCH WITH A PUNCH , four wide around the turn, challenged for the lead in upper stretch then failed to sustain his bid. IRISH BEAU , four wide leaving the backstretch, chased the pace and gave way in midstretch. WOLSELEY BAY showed speed inside horses and gave way. HILL TIE , fractious in the starting gate, raced wide entering the stretch and was not a factor. NUMBER FIFTY TWO , shuffled back soon after the break, was not a factor and passed tired horses. THE FRENCH BEAR , wide on the turn, was not a factor. WILDLY LEAKS was outrun. DISRUPTIVE , a forward factor three wide, gave way entering the stretch. GOMEDALDEE set the pace and faltered in upper stretch. BETH'S MOONSAIL was outrun.
