Footnotes

MESA DRIVE stalked the pace, circled the turn in the three path, closed steadily the final furlong and was up in time. BEE RAPID , angled to the rail midway down the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, eased out to the two path near the eighth pole and rallied between horses. GATOR GOLD , sent to the early lead, set the pace along the rail and gave way grudgingly. COLDBLACK chased the pace racing in the two path and lacked the necessary rally. SHARP HARBOUR , in the two path through the stretch, needed more. GENERAL LEE , three wide on the turn, was not a factor. A STREET , steadied in tight quarters leaving the starting gate, was not a factor and left the turn in the five path. SHANGHAI DADDY saved ground and weakened. SOME WAY SOME HOW , squeezed back leaving the starting gate, raced in the three path turning for home and was not a serious factor. MY RAYMONDO ducked in after hopping at the break then trailed.
