CEE'S FAST bobbled outward at the break making contact with MISS WILKO, settled early, advanced between rivals under a ride entering the lane, shifted out five wide past the eighth pole, closed determinedly under pressure and forged clear in the final thirty yards. OUR FAVORITE set a rated pace off the rail, moved clear around the turn, opened up when roused in upper stretch, drifted out late and could not withstand the winner's charge. COUNT CHA SHOTS saved ground early, angled out mid turn and came four wide for the drive, drifted in briefly in upper stretch, was corrected soon after, split rivals and finished with interest. SHEA BALLETT stumbled and bumped at the break, lagged back, saved ground advancing into the stretch, was guided out for running room the final eighth and finished with interest. SEEKING MILLIE chased the pace towards the inside, was steadied off the heels of KEN SING A SONG near the three sixteenths marker, altered inward and kept on willingly. DOMESTIC ROSE , bumped at the break, lagged far back around the, was taken extremely wide into the lane and had some late action. NORTHERN TRAIN leaned in and was brushed at the break, moved up four wide nearing the lane then flattened out. CAFE RENDEZVOUS rushed up early, was ridden along forcing the pace three to four wide and weakened in upper stretch. KEN SING A

SONG stalked towards the inside and weakened. MISS WILKO , bumped at the break, raced wide and faded. GOOD GIRLS DONT was outrun. LANDOFMANYCATS dropped back. TANANA TANGO faltered entering the lane, eased late and was reported to have bled.
