GRAND ASSASSIN dueled two to three wide through quick fractions, went clear in mid stretch, drifted out and prevailed under a drive. SHARMA, taken to rate off the rail, advanced between rivals in mid stretch, angled in, drew even and just missed in a solid effort. IN TANDEM stalked the dueling leaders outside, was floated out late and came up empty. TREY BEAR saved ground early, swung wide and rallied late. GUTENBERG dueled along the rail and weakened late. COURSE LITE chased the pace and faded. MALIBU MOON COMA failed to menace. WACO DIME was off slowly. WHITE HART LANE was well wide throughout. MYE'S BOY chased the pace three wide and tired. AMERICAN CHIEF broke slowly. MIZZEN MOST was outrun.
