Footnotes

NO CROSSING LANE was hustled clear early, set a solid pace in the three path, was maneuvered out to about the five path entering the lane, switched to his correct lead soon after, responded to stout right handed pressure to open up in mid stretch, drifted in late and held a safe margin while kept alert. ONE TO A ROYAL prompted the pace two wide inside rivals, came about four wide for the drive and stayed on well to earn the place. KEY TO A CURE , four to five wide chasing the pace, came up empty through the final furlong. E. Z. PATH stumbled when appearing to clip the heels of LOLA'S CAT near the four and a half furlong marker, recovered entering the turn, angled wide near the three eighths pole, gathered momentum five wide between foes nearing the lane and finished up with good energy. THE DEVIL YOU SAY bobbled slightly at the break, chased five wide to the quarter pole, angled in leaving mid stretch but lacked a solid response. SILVER MAPLE , sluggish from the gate, angled to the outside of E.Z. PATH when that one stumbled, shifted back in around the turn and failed to make an impact. LOLA'S CAT chased between rivals, had his heels clipped early, continued between foes to the three eighths pole then faltered. An objection by the rider of E.Z. PATH against ONE TO A ROYAL for alleged interference in the run to the turn was not allowed
