JOEY FRIES pulled his way four wide to a clear lead nearing the five eighths pole, dropped in a bit and set a rated pace, widened while drifting out entering the lane, continued to drift through the stretch but held sway under right handed pressure. ZIO TONY , under the whip into the turn, chased the winner in the four path around the turn then closed up willingly through the final furlong. TEA TOTT , five wide in mid pack, came under a ride around the turn, raced seven wide in upper stretch and closed steadily. R. B. FLOAT lacked speed, circled the turn five wide and rallied mildly. TEA PARTY TIME , between rivals early, chased two wide around the turn and lacked a solid response. VEER had no speed, circled five wide and lacked a rally. CRYPTOLEEN'SCHARM saved ground stalking the winner and faded in the final furlong. I CAN DO IT was outrun while in the two path. OUT OF OUR MINE , taken to rate early while saving ground, gave way. BAATESH flashed speed then dropped back between rivals.
